Integration with Hospital Information Systems

External Protocol enables hospitals to securely establish a connection between EndoXpert Manager and Hospital Information Systems (HIS) or other third-party software applications. This protocol allows key information such as the brand, model, serial number and the status of the endoscope; user and specialist details; and reports of requested processes to be shared.

Integration allows clinical and technical teams to rely on a single, consistent source of information, thereby improving coordination between departments.

By aligning endoscope status with hospital workflow:

- The current status of each endoscope is visible directly within the software application that staff already uses.
- Clinical, CSSD, and technical teams see the same information at the same time without the need for phone calls or manual checks.
- Scheduling, procedure planning, and reprocessing activities reflect the real-time status of each endoscope.
- Delays or exceptions are identified early, before they could impact procedures.
